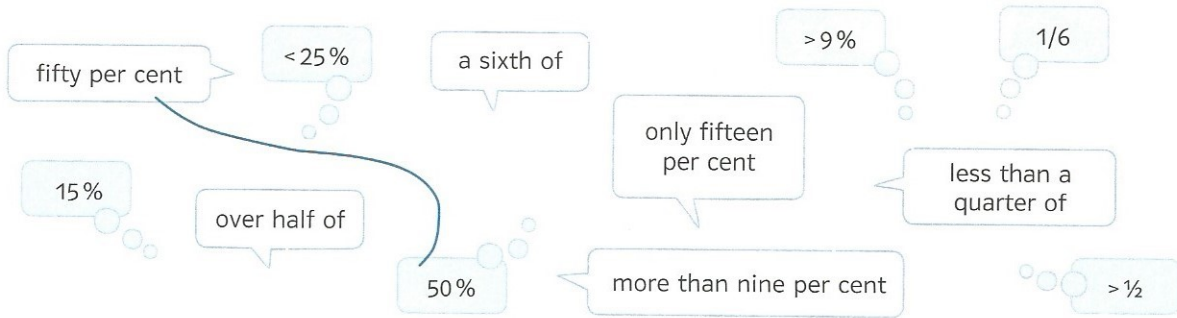

Enjoying German food and beer<sup>1</sup> was the most popular activity. 44 % wanted to do that. The second most popular activity was visiting the Oktoberfest or other beer festivals. Almost a quarter of the students would like to do this. This was probably because in Germany you can drink beer at the age of 16. 17 per cent wanted to go on a boat trip on one of Germany's rivers. And 16 per cent wanted to drive as fast as possible on a German highway. But do they know that you have to be 18 to drive a car? So the results show that going to the Oktoberfest and drinking beer were the most popular things to do.
