## KV 8: Lost in the mountains

In July 2008 three Italian mountaineers<sup>1</sup> climbed Mount Nanga Parbat in Pakistan, one of the highest mountains in the world. One of them fell into a crevasse<sup>2</sup> and died. The other two men couldn't leave their position and hike down because the weather

was too bad. They called for help, but with the fog in the mountains no helicopter could land. After nine days they were finally rescued. Here is what they said at their first press conference.

1. Reporter: How are you? Don't you need to be in a hospital?  
Mountaineer: We're okay. We aren't sick and nothing seems to be broken.
2. Reporter: You had skis. Why didn't you ski down the mountain?  
Mountaineer: It was snowing all day and we couldn't see enough to hike or ski down.
3. Reporter: How did you call for help?  
Mountaineer: We brought satellite phones and we were able to reach the rescue station.
4. Reporter: Why didn't helicopters try to get you out of the mountains?  
Mountaineer: They couldn't land in the fog.
5. Reporter: How did you survive for nine days?  
Mountaineer: We took a lot of water with us, and the helicopters threw down food. We kept warm by staying close to each other.
6. Reporter: Weren't you shocked by your friend's death?  
Mountaineer: Of course. We were very sad that we weren't able to rescue him. But we had to stay calm and think about our own lives.
7. Reporter: Would you go hiking in the mountains again after this experience?  
Mountaineer: Yes, we'll go hiking again as soon as we can.



*Tell your friend about the press conference. Use indirect speech and different reporting verbs. Be careful with the words you have to change.*

*Start like this:* The reporters wanted to know how the men were and whether they didn't need to be in a hospital.
